Minutes of a Meeting of the Niagara
Falls Jewish Federation held at the
home of H.D.Rosberg on Sunday, January
3rd, 1943.

In conjunction with the decisions reached at a general meeting of the Congregation, H.D.Rosberg, the President of the Congregation, made the following appointments to the charity committee: Messrs. H. Bogomolny, S. Wernick, Joe Greenspan, L. Stein, I. Zeldin and T. Dale.

The Committee then decided that its Campaign should carry the character of an annual affair and should assume the name of the Niagara Falls Jewish Federation with the following officers: H. Bogomolny - Chairman; S. Wernick - Vice Chairman; Joe Greenspan - Secretary; L. Stein - Treasurer. Also on the Committee are I. Zeldin, H. D. Rosberg and T. Dale.

The Committee unanimously decided that the Campaign of the Federation should be inaugurated with a dinner on Sunday, January 31st, to which a speaker would be invited. The objective of this Campaign is to raise the sum of \$2500.00.

Among the agencies which will benefit from this Campaign, those mentioned were the following: J. D. C., The Canadian Jewish Congress, U. P. A., Youth Aleeyah, Geverkshafen, Local Charities such as Yeshivos, Hospital, Old Folks Home, J. I. A. S., etc.

Mr. I. Zeldin was appointed Chairman of the Committee to prepare the Banquet inaugurating the Campaign.

There being no further business, the meeting then adjourned.
