



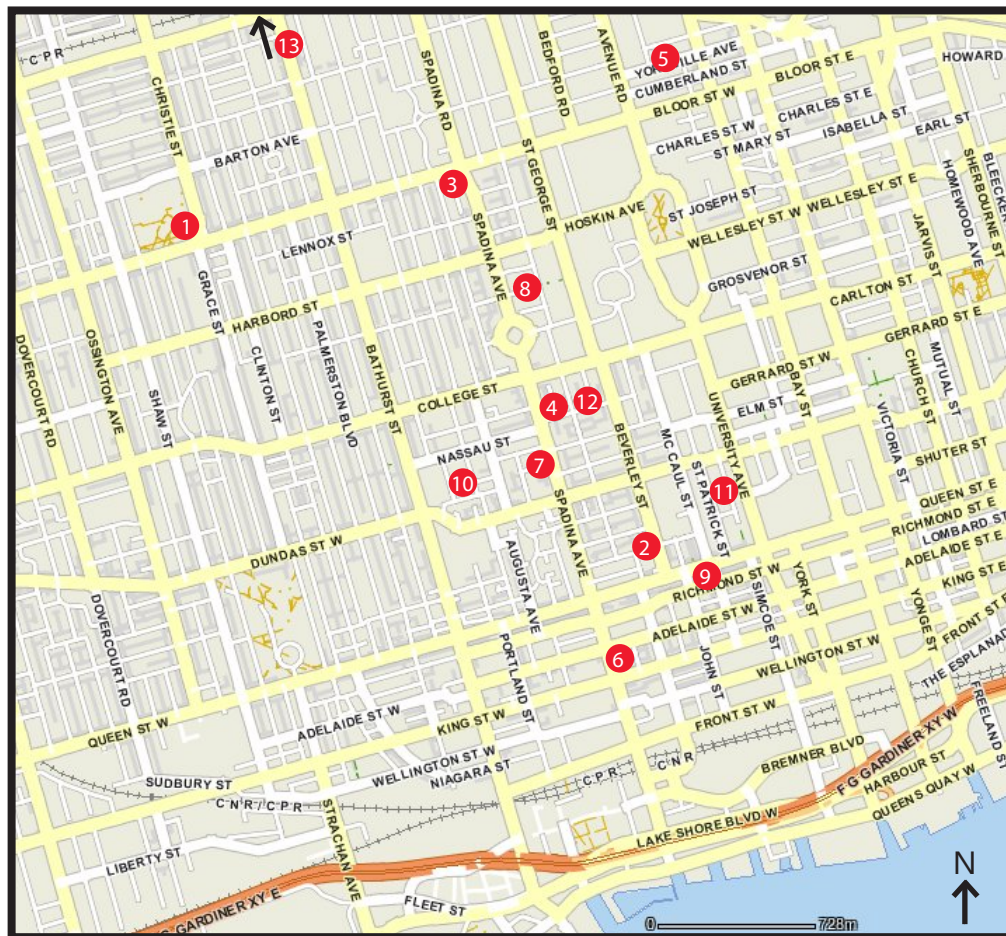
Heritage Toronto
