Dear Mr. Horovitz -      - Re Jewish Cemetery -

Following our conversation of yesterday evening -

Today we attended at the Registry Office and located the property owned by the Jewish Congregation of this Town for the purpose of a Cemetery.

We herewith give you a resume of our search -

Deed No. 8586 - Book "T" - dated January 24th, 1898 - registered in the Cornwall Registry Office on January 24th, 1898 - Grantor - William Colquhoun of the Town of Cornwall, in the County of Stormont, Esquire, with his wife Hester joining to bar her dower to the following grantees -

This is an ordinary deed with the following recitals -

"      Whereas the Baron de Hirsch Congregation of the Town of  
"      Cornwall, in the County of Stormont, at a meeting of the said  
"      Congregation duly called and held in the said Town of Cornwall

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" on the 24th day of January 1898 decided to purchase the  
" parcel of land hereinafter mentioned and described for the  
" purposes of a Cemetery for the said Congregation -

" And whereas the above mentioned parties of the Third  
" part (the Grantees) hereby were at said meeting appointed  
" Trustees for the purpose of taking a conveyance of the said  
" parcel of land and for holding the same in trust for the  
" purpose aforesaid -

The consideration paid was \$117.00 -

A description of the property is as follows -

" Commencing on the east side of the Nine Mile Road at  
" the intersection of the South side of Fifth Street in the Town  
" of Cornwall produced with the East side of the said Nine Mile  
" Road, thence Southerly along the East side of the said Nine  
" Mile Road 1.42 and 5/10 chains, thence North 66 degrees east  
" 7.86 chains, thence North 24 degrees West .09 chains to the  
" intersection of the South side of said Fifth Street, thence  
" Westerly along the continuation of the said South side of said  
" Fifth St. 7.94 chains more or less to the place of beginning.


As far as the books in the Registry Office show the only dealing with this property has been the Grant, particulars of which are given above. The property has never been mortgaged as far as the records in the book show.

We figure from the description that this property lies immediately north of the present sub-division of Laflecheville.
