

The Foundation maintains a large house, a few minutes walk from the Campus and beautifully situated on McDonald Park within view of Lake Ontario.

The House is a meeting place for Jewish students. Prominent speakers and artists are presented in a varied cultural program.

On Friday night the candles are lit and Oneg Shabbath Programs are being held. Purim and Chanukah are celebrated traditionally. The Seder is one of the happiest events of the year and Passover meals are served.

Altogether, there is a dynamic Jewish atmosphere in the House.

Needless to say, there are many social activities, dances and parties. Away from home, your son or daughter need never be without friends or without a Home to call at. There is a very happy informal relationship between students and Rabbi, who is always available to help and guide when necessary.
